



The Scottish Intensive Care Society Nursing and Allied Health Professional Award Competition 2014

What is the award: This is a prestigious annual opportunity for a Nurse or Allied Health Professional to present their work at the SICSAG/SCCTG Combined Annual Meeting on 4th & 5th September 2014 at the Stirling Management Centre, and to be a guest of the Society at the Annual Scientific Meeting to be held on the 22nd and 23rd January 2015 in St Andrews (includes accommodation and meeting registration).

Who can apply: a Nurse or AHP who has undertaken a project or research that demonstrates:

- Original research into an area relevant to critical illness across the care continuum (this could be a master's dissertation or other small project).
- Clinical improvement projects aimed at improving person-centred care for critically ill patients and /or their families/ carers
- Applicants should be a nurse or member of the allied health professions working in Scotland at the time of entry
- A member of the Scottish Intensive Care Society (joining at the time of submission is acceptable)

How to apply: Submit a paper or project summary of about 1000-2000 words in length.

The closing date is Friday 25th July 2014
